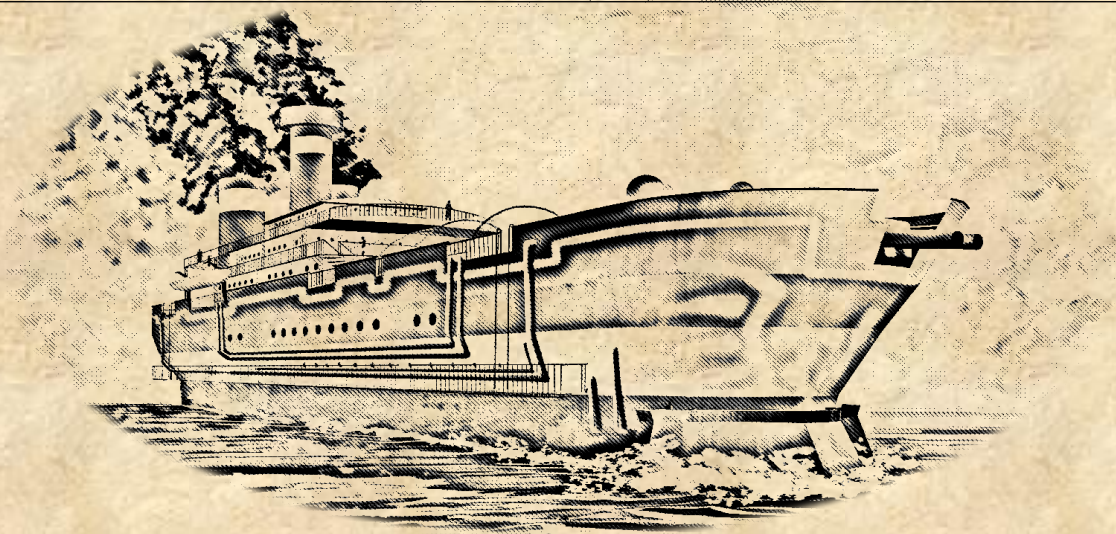


IRONCLAD INAUGURATION

Queen Aurala arrives in Passage

to inaugurate the newest addition to the Royal Navy’s fleet. Barely three years since the end of Last War, Passage, the industrial heart of Aundair, has produced an ironclad warship powered solely by an elemental assisted steam engine, not sail, not needing a Lyrandar heir to captain. Your monarch, Queen Aurala, will come to Passage to inaugurate the ship, and witness the official launch of this mighty vessel on the 12th of Therendor this year. The Brelish chief designer and reconciliationist, Geoff Massarde, claims the vessel to be the equal of any ship in the arsenal of any of the other nations. While its exact specifications are a closely guarded state secret, the soon to be inaugurated R.N.S. Coaltongue, is wooden-hulled but with a heart and skin of iron. The Royal Naval Ship Coaltongue will act as a deterrent against future aggression from Aundair’s enemies across the seas and lakes of Khorvaire. It’s design is a fusion of Brelish-inspired industry and Aundairian arcanotech. ROYAL SHIPYARD LOCKDOWN

Bosum Strand Mayor Griffin Stowe ordered district guards to increase the presence of uniformed and plain clothes officers around the Royal Shipyard and Royal Square while the *R.N.S. Coaltongue* is docked and in preparation for the arrival of Queen Aurala and other V.I.P. guests next week. While Royal Eyes of Aundair Director Thuel Racannoch remains in Fairhaven, the head of the Passage branch, Lady Inspectress Margaret ir’Saxby, has promised the support of her agents to the security effort. Assistant Chief Inspector Stover Delft is overseeing the REA-teams in the run up to the launch party. The city guards and the Royal Eyes of Aundair will be providing security for the event itself, at which thousands of visitors are expected. Security is said to be tight, especially considering the queen's own attendance. REA Assistant Chief Inspector Stover Delft has been quoted as saying, "We do not anticipate trouble, but current dissatisfaction in the Docker community means that we will be on our guard." Sightseers and well-wishers will gather in Royal Square, although only 700 will be permitted to cross the bridge to Fleet Square.

NAVAL LAUNCH V.I.P. GUEST LIST

The R.N.S. Coaltongue launch party is sure to be the largest gathering of society’s upper crust Passage has seen since the opening of the Stanfield Canal. Most importantly, Queen Aurala will be in attendance, along with her brother, First Warlord and Minister of Magic Adal ir’Wynarn, and her cousin and Aundair’s ambassador to the Unseen Court, Duchess Ethelyn ir’Brassek of Windshire. Passage’s own Governor Roland Stanfield will also accompany the queen. Attorney General Shreve and District Mayors Stowe (Bosum Strand), Putnam (Central), Idylls (Cloudwood), Dekker (Lower Woods), Choir (North Shore), Gohins (Parity Lake), Pepper (Pine Island), and Robinson (Stray River) will be at the Royal Shipyard to greet the queen’s party. Mayor Reed Macbannin (The Nettles) has not returned his invitation yet, and word from his staff is that there has been an unusual increase in activity among the dark spirits of Cauldron Hill that the mayor has been busy quelling. Geoff Massarde, chief designer of the R.N.S. Coaltongue, and noted industrialists Guy Goodson, and Benedict Pemberton will represent Passage’s industrial sector. Colonel Sebastien Serontain (The Battalion) has been sent to represent the Aundairian Army and Rear Admiral Morris Dawkins will be the

naval representative for Passage’s naval defenses. Captain Rutger d’Lyrandar (R.N.S. Impossible), will be standing in for Viceroy Leland d’Cannith, who has been afflicted with severe exhaustion, and for Baron Kwanti d’Orien, who can’t be present in Passage at the time. The only other dragonmarked house present will be House Ghallanda, as Hanna d’Ghallanda will be responsible for the food and drink during the maiden voyage. Also not in attendance are Fairhaven’s Catherine ir’Romana—the noted primalist and close friend of Duchess Ethelyn has been quite public in her anti-tech views {see SKYSEERS DREAM DOOM OF DREADNOUGHT, pg. 7}—along with the liaison to the Unseen Court Asrabey Varal {see UNSEEN COURT UNINVITES SELF, pg. 7}, and Brelish Foreign Minister Lya Jierre^T who’s presence in Flint so close to the launch of a new warship has nationalist factions accusing Brelish espionage.

DOCKER DILEMMA

Unionizing Agonizing for Worker-Owner Relations

Retired ferry captain Thames Grimsley, still recovering from wounds received at the hands of over exuberant district guardsmen during the last docker riot, has been seen organizing for workers’ right from Bosum Strand to the Nettles. Grimsley is calling for a complete unionization of waterfront workers as the only way to achieve better pay, fair working hours, and compensation for workplace accidents. TREMORS TOPPLE TEACUPS

Flint had no history of earthquakes, so the small tremors felt this last year has restaurateurs grousing and researchers baffled.
