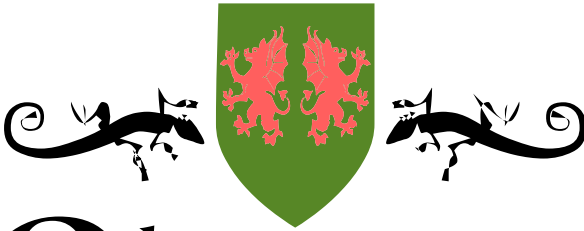

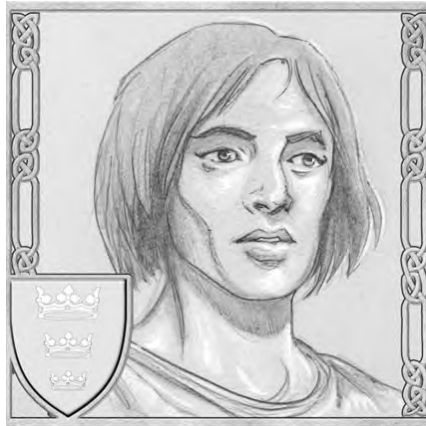

Hospitality

Hospitality: If one refuses, lose 1 point of both hospitality and honor. One night (the minimum by tradition), no effect.

A week is a check in hospitality.

Through the winter, a point of hospitality and a check in generous.

Feeding them for the winter is 1 £F and earns a generous check.

Fixing their gear is 1 £C. This also earns a generous check.

All three generous checks instead becomes a point.

Adventure: The Færie Knight

A knight has taken up residence in Shrewton Manor. He isn't human. He's also not paying taxes.

He can be chased out by any of several means, including a priest blessing him, Besting him in a joust, or managing to pay him a quittance of 25 £

He's charming, easily 6'4", and has a pentacle hanging from his neck, and on his shield. His draw is of southwest Devon. His cloak is of gray denim.
