## HOW TO MAKE 5E STYLE STAT-BLOCKS

Get Valloric's Web Component for 5e statblocks:

Input your monster's information in the spreadsheet, using the DMG pages 273-283 as a guideline.

Copy the HTML statblock to a plain text editor like TextWrangler or TextEdit, and save it as a HTML file.

Note: If you're using TextEdit on OS X, make sure to go into Preferences and set the format to Plain Text.

Open up the saved HTML file in your Chrome browser.

Take a screen capture, and either import the captured image directly into your document, OR clean up the edges of the image in Photoshop/GIMP using the magic wand tool first and then import it into your document.
