

Bridge Troll	Level 9 Solo Brute
Large natural humanoid	XP 2,000
<b>Initiative</b> +7 <b>Senses</b> Perception +11 <b>Noxious Breath</b> aura 1; living enemies in the aura take a –2 penalty to attack rolls. <b>HP</b> 400(320); <b>Bloodied</b> 200(160) <b>Regeneration</b> 10 (if the troll takes acid or fire damage, regeneration does not function until the end of its next turn) <b>AC</b> 20; <b>Fortitude</b> 23, <b>Reflex</b> 20, <b>Will</b> 19 <b>Saving Throws</b> +5 <b>Speed</b> 8 <b>Action Points</b> 2	
⚔ <b>Claw</b> (standard; at-will)	
Reach 2; +13 vs AC; 2d6+6 damage.	
⚔ <b>Two Claw Rend</b> (standard; at-will)	
Two claw attacks, +13 vs AC; 2d6+6 damage. If both attacks hit the same target the bridge troll does an additional	
⚔ <b>Frenzied Strike</b> (free, when the troll's attack bloodies an enemy, at-will)	
The troll makes a claw attack.	
⚔ <b>Don't stand so close to me</b> (immediate interrupt, when enemy moves adjacent)	
+13 vs Armor Class; 2d6+6 damage and the target is pushed 2 squares and knocked prone.	
⚔ <b>Have a drink</b> (standard; recharge [2][2] [2][2] [2][2], while under his bridge)	
Reach 2; +13 vs AC; 2d10+6 damage and a Medium or smaller target is grabbed and submerged underwater (until escape). The target takes 1d10+6 damage at the beginning of its turn until it can escape the grab. The bridge troll can grab up to two targets in this manner. Releasing a target is a free action. As long as the bridge troll has one target grabbed it can not use its Two Claw Rend, if it has two targets grabbed any attack it makes releases as many targets as claws he uses in the attack.	
<b>Troll Healing</b> ♦ <b>Healing</b>	
If the troll is reduced to 0 hit points or fewer by an attack that does not deal acid or fire damage, it rises on its next turn (as a move action) with 20 hit points.	
<b>Alignment</b> Chaotic evil <b>Languages</b> Giant <b>Skills</b> Athletics +15, Endurance +14 <b>Str</b> 22 (+10) <b>Dex</b> 16 (+7) <b>Wis</b> 14 (+6) <b>Con</b> 20 (+9) <b>Int</b> 5(+1) <b>Cha</b> 10 (+4)
