<b>CLASS. Wizard</b>	
• Spellcasting	
<u>Spell slots</u> : finishing a long rest restores any expended spell slots.	

<u>Spellbook</u> : at 1st level you have a spellbook containing six 1st level wizard spells of your choice. You can cast a wizard spell as a ritual if that spell has the ritual tag and you have the spell in your spellbook. You don't need to have the spell prepared.	
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• <u>Arcane Recovery</u> : During a short rest recover up to 3 levels of expended spell slots (5th level or lower). You can use this feature again after finishing a long rest.	
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• <b>Arcane Traditions (Enchantment)</b>	
• <u>Arcane Tradition Feature (Enchantment Savant)</u> : The gold and time you must spend to copy an enchantment spell into your spellbook is halved	

• <u>Arcane Tradition Feature (Hypnotic Gaze)</u> : As an action, choose one creature you can see within 5ft. If it can see or hear you, it must succeed on a Wisdom saving throw (DC15) or be charmed until the end of your next turn. Its speed drops to 0, and it is incapacitated and visibly dazed. On subsequent turns, you can use your action to maintain this effect, extending its duration until the end of your next turn.	
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The effect ends if you move more than 5ft away from it, if it can neither see nor hear you, or if it takes damage. Once the effect ends, or if it succeeds on its initial saving throw, you can't use this feature on it again until you finish a long rest	
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• <u>Arcane Tradition Feature (Instinctive Charm)</u> : When a creature you can see within 30ft makes an attack roll against you, use your reaction to divert the attack, provided that another creature is within the attack's range. The attacker must make a Wisdom saving throw (DC15), on a fail the attacker must target the creature that is closest to you. If multiple creatures are closest, the attacker chooses which one to target.	
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On a success, you can't use this feature on the attacker again until you finish a long rest. You must choose to use this feature before knowing whether the attack hits or misses.	
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Creatures that can't be charmed are immune to this effect	
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
