

BARD COLLEGE: COLLEGE OF HEART

As long as music has existed to record history and inspire battle, it has also been used to bring peace to the world and heal the sick. Bards of the College of Heart use their abilities to bring joy to their comrades and hope to innocents.

It is not uncommon to meet the stray Bard of the Heart in a local hospital or Inn, singing to the weary and the down trodden. They live to help others and will not stand by in the face of any evil. While they do not carry the magic of the Lore Bard nor the fight of the Valor Bard, they find ways to help in their own unique way.

BONUS SPELLS

Beginning when you join the College of Heart at third level, any time that you gain a bard level, you may replace one of your bard spells with a spell from the cleric spell list that is of a level for which you have spell slots. Any cleric spell gained from this feature is treated as a bard spell for you.

HEALING MELODY

At 3rd level, you may expend uses of your Bardic Inspiration to put restore hope and livelihood into others. Whenever you cast a spell that restores health to a creature, you may expend one use of your Bardic Inspiration to restore additional hit points equal to the die roll plus your charisma modifier to the target creature.

FEARLESS MARCH

Beginning at 6th level, a bard of the College of Heart can inspire bravery and determination into the hearts of their comrades. A Heart Bard may spend 5 minutes to express their confidence in their party by way of inspirational song or rousing speech. Up to 6 creatures, including the user, within thirty feet of the bard have advantage on saving throws against fear and are immuned to being charmed. This effect lasts for 1 hour before wearing off.

URGENT HEALING

At the 14th level, you gain the ability to save your comrades from the brink of death using your rousing song. Whenever a creature within 30 feet of you drops to 0 hit points, you may use your reaction to expend one use of Bardic Inspiration to have them drop to 1 hit point instead.
