The Incestuous Affair of King Aodhan's Danorian Fiancee?

Documents obtained by the Risuri Record this past week suggest some irregularities in the legal marriage status of the King's fiancee, the

Danorian Minister of Outsiders, Lya Jierre, Niece of Danorian Sovereign Han Jierre. Tensions continue to threaten catastrophic war between Danor and Risur leading into the Spring 13 Peace Summit. Last year, the RNS IMPOSSIBLE narrowly defused what was thought to be an inevitable stand-off at Axis Island in the Yerasol Archipelago. More recently, there have been rumors of RHC Naval forces clashing with Danorian vessels off the coast of Vendricce, Crisillyir. With the peace summit approaching, the scheduling the marriage of King Aodhan to Lya Jierre is a key

agenda item, according to Berian mediator, Ambassador Brakken of Heffanita. Though these nuptials are a thinly veiled political pact, they may be legally illegitimate from the outset. Danorian Teiflings are notoriously xenophobic, and dictatorial intermarriage for racial purity has been a longstanding tradition for hundreds of years. Rumors have it that Han Jierre had an assassination attempt shortly after cessation of hostilities in the last Yerasol War, and since has regularly conducted purges and house arrests of outspoken members of the token opposition parties. Unnamed sources have reached out to the Risuri Record and have alleged that Lya and Luc Jierre were not only betrothed, but also married prior to Lya's pledge to wed King Aodhan some four years ago. And yet, after all this time, the union has still not come to fruition, because Lya secretly continues to abscond with her brother in licentious rendezvous across the Northern continents of Lanjyr, in spite of the annulment to the covert marriage. The Danorian delegation arrives amid the 8th week of docker protests, which are scheduled to continue throughout the Peace Summit. Risur can ill afford free trade deals with exploitive capitalist-industrialists from Danor. Wages are already abysmal, and industrial work in the City of Flint, where the talks are being held, continues to hemorrhage jobs as exploitive companies like Pemberton Industries look to expand production overseas. What Risur needs are not more empty promises of peace, but a more equitable distribution of wealth.
